Ages 4-7

Follow directions

Good listener/take turns

**Exhibit manners** 

Know proper greetings

Make eye contact during conversation

Show respect for elders

Ages 8-12

Serve and ask how can I help?
Know how to make good 1st impression
Ask for help / resolve conflict
Take a phone message
Can compromise
Carry conversation clearly
Appropriate behavior to occasion

Ages 13-15

schedule/cancel appointments understand body language use public transport with others talk to teachers about assignments check in with parents/show respect participate in service activities

Ages 16-18

How /when to negotiate/compromise hold others responsible use public transportation alone fill out job application/ or medical forms initiate contact with colleges/employer understand public/personal info safety coordinate schedules with others

Here are some tips for your classes

Pre-2

Teach whole body listening and expected behaviors in routines

3-5 practice working in small group or partner work. Ask your class to look around and see what needs to be done. Play take a message for notes where each person write down a part of the lesson and then reads to group at end for summary

Middle School/ High School

Teach ground rules for group work. Use a planner, do group work with timelines. Email/skype another classroom or culture Incorporate service into assignments. Maybe create some jobs for classroom or school and have them fill out applications for positions.
